

QUICK START GUIDE



- 1. Remove the insulating tape from the battery compartment at the base.
- 2. Select the unit measure for Kilograms (kg), Pounds (lb) or Stones (st) by pressing the Unit Convertor button.
- 3. Place the scale right side up, on a firm and level surface.
- 4. Gently step onto the scale to activate it. Make sure your feet are equally apart, weight distributed evenly and you stand perfectly still.
- 5. Once a steady reading is taken, the display will lock and flash to indicate your weight.
- 6. The scale automatically turns off after approximately 8 seconds when left idle.


OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Please retain this Manual for future reference and read the instructions carefully before use to ensure the correct operation of the scale.

This device is intended for indoor domestic use only and is not intended for commercial, industrial or trade use.

Preparing your scale

- 1. Remove all packaging before weighing then turn the scale over and gently place face down on a clean, flat table or benchtop.
- 2. Pull out the insulating tape from the battery compartment. This will allow the scale to function. If necessary, remove the cover first.








- 3. Next select the unit measure for Kilograms (kg), Pounds (lb) or Stones (st) by pressing the Unit Convertor button. Your scale is now ready for use.
- 4. Turn it over and place your scale on a firm and level surface. Use on soft or flexible floor material (like carpet or a chair mat) will result in inconsistent and inaccurate readings due to the instability of the floor.
- 5. This is a 'Step on Start' scale. Gently step onto the scale to turn it on. Ensure that the glass top is kept dry as it could become slippery when wet. When standing on your scale, make sure your feet are placed equally apart on it, your weight is distributed evenly

between your feet and you stand perfectly still. Movement, leaning backward or forward and not standing evenly on your scale will affect the accuracy of the weight displayed.

- 6. Once a steady reading is taken the display will lock and flash to indicate your final weight.
- 7. It turns off automatically after about 8 secs when left idle.

Readout Warnings

Low battery indicator



Batteries are losing power and must be replaced. Remember to always use fresh, good quality batteries. Ensure that battery polarity is correct when inserting into the battery compartment. If unsure, follow the markings inside.



Overloading



The scale has exceeded its capacity (over 180kg / 397lb / 28st). Remove the weight immediately to avoid possible damage to the scale's sensor.

Weighing Error



This appears as you step off the scale indicating a computation error. Please step back onto the scale gently and stand perfectly still to re-weigh yourself.

Care and Maintenance of the Scale

- When necessary, wipe the glass platform with a slightly damp cloth. Avoid the use of corrosive cleaners.
- Ensure that the glass top is kept dry as it could become slippery when wet.
- Do not immerse the scale in water.
- Handle the scale with care. Do not jump or pound on it.
- Do not attempt to dismantle the scale. It does not contain parts that may be repaired by the user.
- Do not subject the scale to extreme temperatures.
- Remove the batteries if the scale is not being used for a long period of time.
- Should your scale reach the end of its working life, please separate it from other types of waste and dispose of responsibly. If unsure, check with your local authority for recycling advice.

Hints on Using Bathroom Scales

Moving your scale around frequently may affect its accuracy, so if possible, try to leave it in a permanent position that has a firm and even surface. Use on soft or flexible floor material (like carpet or a chair mat) will result in inconsistent and inaccurate readings due to the instability of the floor.

Body weight varies with a number of factors including the amount of food recently eaten, the amount of waste recently expelled by the body, vigorous exercise and of course, the clothes you wear. If possible, try to weigh yourself at the same time of day under the same conditions and with the same clothes on, or preferably no clothes on. This will reduce the chance of getting unexplained variations in weight.

Do not try to compare your weight on a number of scales. You may find you get different readings which can be frustrating and confusing. The differences could be due to some scales being slightly inaccurate and/or your own body weight varying due to one or more of the factors mentioned above.

Even if a scale appears slightly inaccurate, it will normally give you an accurate measurement of the variance in your weight from the previous times you weighed yourself. Most people purchase a scale to monitor their weight every now and then or to monitor loss or gain of weight during a loss/gain program they have chosen. If you regularly use the same scale under the same conditions, it should monitor changes in your weight accurately.

Warning about Batteries
